Dear Readers

2025 presented Edisun Power Europe with a set of challenges that tested the resilience of our operating portfolio while, at the same time, confirmed the strategic direction we set out at the end of year 2024. Weather-related headwinds, unforeseen operational disruptions, and ongoing electricity price pressures during daytime weighed on our annual results. Our transformation towards a leading European “Renewables to AI” company with major focus in developing power solutions for data centers is gathering significant momentum. The global data center market has entered a supercycle, with AI workload expected to be more than triple between 2025 and 2030 according to a study from McKinsey. The shift toward AI is the dominant force with hyperscale operators leading the way. With impressive investments in data centers, getting access to the power is utmost critical. Here, our large-scale “Fuencarral to AI” project in the Madrid region, with a total solar plant capacity of 941 MWp and a data center size of 250 MW IT, is one of the largest renewables-plus-data-center projects currently under development in Europe.
